



Lyle "Dom" Domina

November 12, 1933 - September 16, 2008

Lyle Donovan "Dom" Domina, 74, of DeKalb, Ill., died Tuesday, Sept. 16, 2008, at The Illinois Veterans Home, Manteno. He was born Nov. 12, 1933, in Hartington, Neb., the son of Lloyd and Eda (Strivens) Domina. He married Donetta Wagner July 23, 1960, at Trinity Lutheran Church in Wolbach, Neb. Mr. Domina was a professor of English and computer science at Northern Illinois University. He is a veteran of the U.S. Air Force, where he was a Russian language translator for four years during the Korean War. Mr. Domina was a volunteer for the Juvenile Court System. Surviving are his wife, Donetta Domina of DeKalb; a daughter and son-in-law, Tanya Domina of Mount Pleasant, Mich., and Paul McGrath of Hammond, Ind.; a son, daughter-in-law and grandson, Chris Domina, Carrie Leeb and Milo Leeb-Domina of San Francisco, Calif.; a daughter, son-in-law and two granddaughters, Kyla, Bruce, Chloe and Caitlin Seegers of Westchester; two sisters and a brother-in-law, Annabelle Anderson of New Castle, Neb., and Janet and Glen Olson of Laurel, Neb.; four brothers and three sisters-in-law, Marvin and Jackie Domina of Coleridge, Neb., Dean and Betty Domina of Merrill, Mich., Alan and Karen Domina of Lincoln, Neb., and Elmer Domina of Atwood, Kan.; and his mother-in-law, Vivian Wagner of Wolbach, Neb. He was preceded in death by his parents and a sister, Eileen.
