Visitation will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Thursday at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee, where services will be held at 10 a.m. Friday. Rev. Dennis Settles will officiate. Burial will be in Papineau Cemetery. Memorials may be made to the American Cancer Society-Leukemia Research. Ms. Hinrichs was most recently children's librarian for the Lake County Public Library System. She had also taught at St. Martin of Tours School. She was born July 5, 1953, in Kankakee, the daughter of Donald L. and Virginia Taron Beaupre. She married William F. Hinrichs April 6, 1974 at St. Teresa Catholic Church, Kankakee. She was an artist and enjoyed art, sewing, cooking, and reading. Surviving are three daughters and one son-in-law, Amanda Hinrichs of Ft.
