Visitation for Lynn M. Jennings, 41, of Bourbonnais, will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Monday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 11 a.m. Tuesday at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Bradley, where she was a member. The Rev. Bill DeWaan will officiate. Burial will be in All Saints Cemetery, Bourbonnais. In lieu of flowers, memorials may be made for her children's education. She died Thursday (Feb. 5, 2009) at Provena St. Mary's Hospital, surrounded by her loving family, following a lengthy battle with breast cancer. Mrs. Jennings was a staffing specialist for Manpower Temporary Employment Agency. She was born Jan. 15, 1968, in Kankakee, the daughter of Ambrose and Joanne Marcotte Davis. She was a graduate of Bradley-Bourbonnais Community High School. She was a member of Body Works Fitness Center, enjoyed reading and supported cancer fundraising events. Her children were first in her life. Surviving are her husband, Mark A. Jennings, whom she married Oct. 15, 1988, at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Bradley; two daughters, Taylor Jennings and Sydney Jennings, both at home; two sisters and one brother-in-law, Kathy Davis of South Hadley, Mass., Brenda and Dennis Dayhoff of Galena, Mo.; five brothers and four sisters-in-law, Bruce and Tina Davis of Bourbonnais, Mic and Michelle Davis of Mont Belvieu, Texas, Greg Davis, Jim and Rhonda Davis, all of Bradley, Tom and Beth Davis of Frankfort; father-in-law and mother-in-law, Gary and Marty West of Bourbonnais; grandparents-in-law, Bill and Vera Lustik of Bradley; and several nieces and nephews, aunts, uncles,

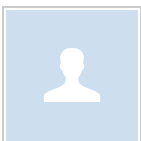
