A memorial graveside service for Marcella E. Reed, 103, of Pontiac, formerly of Kankakee, will be held at 2 p.m. Wednesday in Grand Prairie Cemetery, Bonfield. The Rev. Kathy Sweet will officiate. Cremation rites were accorded by the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Crematory, west Kankakee. Memorials may be made to St. Mark United Methodist Church, Kankakee, where she was a member. She died Tuesday (April 7, 2009) at Evenglow Health Center in Pontiac. Mrs. Reed worked at the Kankakee Public Library for five years and retired from Le Cour's after 17 years as a salesperson. She was born Oct. 31, 1905, in Bonfield, the daughter of Ambrose and Amelia Bossert Schaal. Her husband, Lester Reed, whom she married Nov. 19, 1925, is deceased. She was a member of the Eastern Star and the Senior Citizens. She was a volunteer at the Salvation Army, Heritage Village, and delivered Meals on Wheels. She sang in the Salvation Army chorus and enjoyed traveling, reading and volunteering. Surviving are cousins, including Eldon and Elaine Bossert of Kankakee, and Jeanne and Fred Zabel of Dwight.
