Marcella M. Senesac, 86, of Manteno, died Saturday (Jan. 31, 2009) at Riverside Medical Center. Visitation will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Monday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Manteno, with a 6:30 p.m. wake service. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 11 a.m. Tuesday at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Manteno, where she was a member. Father Al Heideke will officiate. Burial will be in St. Joseph Cemetery, Manteno. Memorials may be made to the Manteno Knights of Columbus, St. Jude Children's Hospital or to St. Stanislaus Church Soup Kitchen in Chicago. Mrs. Senesac was a registered nurse at St. Mary's Hospital, Hillman Hospital, Manteno State Hospital and retired from Howe Developmental Center. Her husband, Earl Senesac, whom she married Nov. 23, 1946, at St. Patrick Catholic Church in Kankakee, died May 9, 1986. She was a graduate of Herscher High School and received a Bachelor of Science degree in nursing from the University of St. Francis in Joliet. She was a member of the CCW at her church and Ladies of the Moose. She did volunteer work for St. Joseph Church Food Pantry, Meals on Wheels and St. Stanislaus Church Soup Kitchen in Chicago. Surviving are two sons and one daughter-in-law, Roger Senesac of Manteno, Randall and Jennifer Senesac of Bourbonnais; two daughters and sons-in-law, Julaine and Anthony Langlois of Grant Park, Patricia and James Altman of Chicago; six grandchildren, Justin and Jacqueline Langlois, Ryan and Grant Senesac, Francis and Nicholas Altman;

one great-grandchild, Austin Langlois; and one brother and sister-in-law, Bernard and Pat Schmidt of Yuma, Ariz. Her parents are deceased.
