Margaret M. Guimond, age 93, of Kankakee passed away, of natural causes, Tuesday, January 23, 2018 at Presence Heritage Village in Kankakee. She was born November 2, 1924 in Buckingham, the daughter of Fred & Theresa Fritz Feller. Margaret married Leonard Guimond on June 28, 1947 at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Bradley. He preceded her in death on January 5, 2015.

Margaret was a former employee of American Marietta. She was a co-founder of Birth Right of Kankakee. Margaret was a longtime parishioner of St. Martin of Tours Church in Kankakee and was also a member of the C.C.W. She was a longtime volunteer at St. Mary's Hospital. Margaret also volunteered for Meals on Wheels and many other organizations. She was a two-time St. Martins or Tours C.C.W. Woman of the Year.

Surviving are three sons and daughters-in-law, Larry & Lori Guimond of St. Anne, Jon & Susan Guimond of Kankakee, and Terry & Debbie Guimond of Justin, Texas; two daughters and sons-in-law, Suzanne & Rodney Good of Goshen, Indiana and Dianne & George Sturgeon of Atwater, Ohio; eighteen grandchildren; twenty-three great-grandchildren; and four great-great grandchildren. In addition to her husband, she is preceded in death by her parents; six sisters and five brothers.

A funeral mass will be celebrated at 12 noon Friday, January 26, 2018 at St. John Paul II- West Campus in Kankakee, formerly St. Martin of Tours. Rev. John Peeters will celebrate the mass. A visitation will follow the mass that

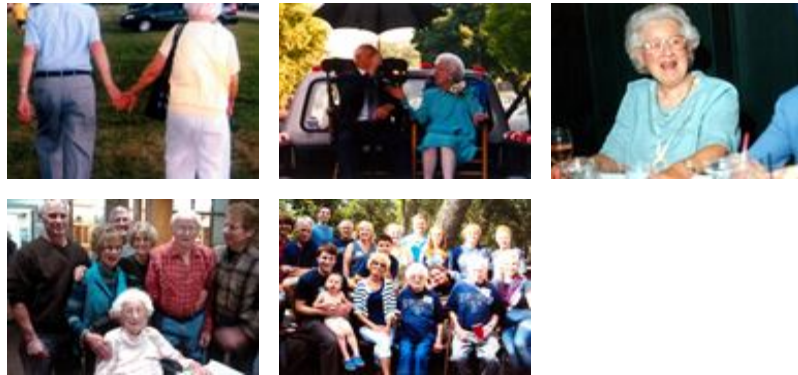
