Marian A. McKenna, 96, of Kankakee, passed away on Friday, June 14, 2024, at Courtyard Estates in Herscher. Marian was born December 5, 1927, in rural Kankakee County; the daughter of John and Edith (Knittel) O'Connor. Marian married John "Jack" E. McKenna in Irwin in 1952; they shared 40 years of marriage before he preceded her in death in 1992. Marian was a member of St. James Catholic Church and Council of Catholic Women in Irwin and formerly St. Patrick Catholic Church in Kankakee. She and Jack were active in Knights of Columbus Council 745 where Marian was on the Ladies Auxiliary. She was an excellent quilter and euchre player, who enjoyed cooking and baked the best pies. She loved camping; most of all Marian loved spending time with her family. Marian worked for many years for State Senator Jerry Joyce, the county treasurer, the circuit clerk, and Knights of Columbus.

Marian is survived by her children: Cindy (Jim) Traver of East Peoria, IL, Kathy (Charlie) Olson of Lindenhurst, IL, and John McKenna of Kankakee, her grandchildren: Amy (Bryan) Fuller, Alyssa (Carissa Isbell) Traver, Jack (Kim) Olson, and Maddie Olson. She was "Grandma-the-Great" to great-grandchildren: Ethan and Emma Fuller, and another great-grandchild expected in July. She is also survived by several nieces and nephews.

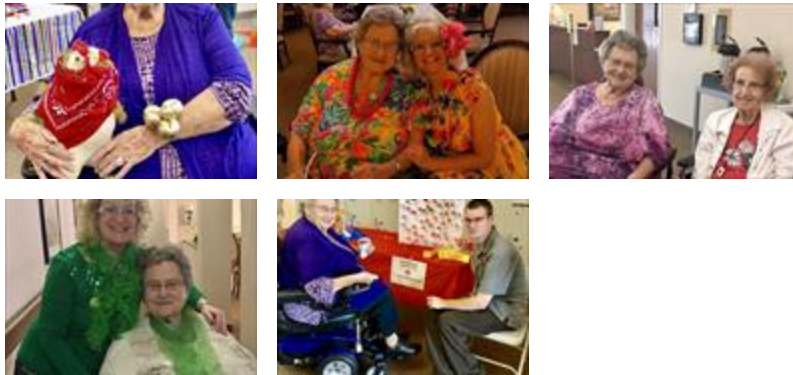
