Marissa Noel Grant, 18, of Bourbonnais, passed away Friday (March 16, 2018) at Loyola University Medical Center in Maywood.

She was born Dec. 21, 1999, in Clinton Township, Mich., the daughter of Andrew Grant and Mary Blanchette.

Marissa was a current student at Kankakee Community College and had graduated early from Bradley-Bourbonnais Community High School. She had attained her CNA certificate and was a dental assistant at Bradley Dental. She was a dedicated and hard-working young woman.

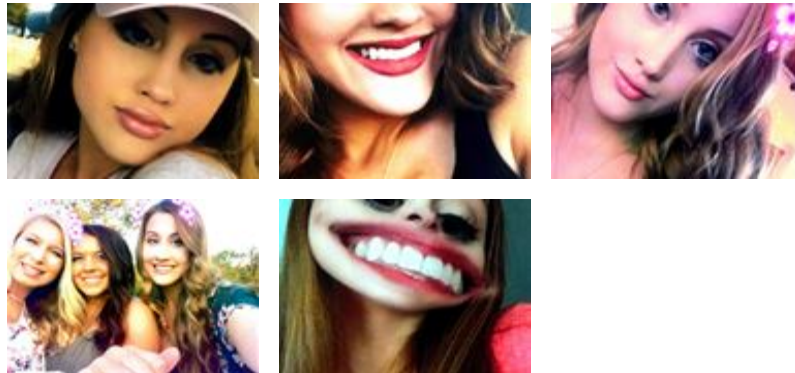
