Mark J. Hanold, age 97, of Bradley passed away Sunday, April 1, 2018 at his home. He was born February 2, 1921 in Stambaugh, MI, the son of Gust & Adella Farrell Hanold. Mark married Margie M. Friend on March 23, 1946 at St. Agnus Church in Iron River, MI. She preceded him in death on December 28, 2009.

Mark retired from A.O. Smith Company in Kankakee, where he worked as a Former Plant Manager & Director of Operations from 1946-1982. He was a member of the YMCA, Chamber of Commerce, and VFW. Mark was a veteran of the United States Army, serving during WWII in the European Theater. He was a parishioner of St. Joseph Catholic Church in Bradley.

Surviving are three sons and two daughters-in-law, Rick Hanold of Bourbonnais, Peter W. & Vicki Hanold of Portage, MI, and Greg & Patti Hanold of Batesville, MS; two daughters and one son-in-law, Mary Ellen Harvell of Kankakee and Kathleen & Gary Watland of Ft.
