Mark Moline -- MomenceMark D. Moline, 47, of Momence, died Saturday (March 11, 2006) at his home, after an extended illness. Visitation will be from 4-8 p.m. Tuesday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais, and from 10 a.m. Wednesday at St. Patrick Catholic Church, Momence, until the 11 a.m. services. Rev. Vern Arseneau will officiate. Memorials may be made for his children's education. Mr. Moline was the owner of MDM Architecture. He was born March 12, 1958, in Park Ridge, the son of Ronald and Janet Jones Moline. He was a 1976 graduate of Westview High School and a graduate of the University of Illinois School of Architecture. He was a three time recipient of the Earl Prize for Design. He was a member of St. Patrick Catholic Church, Momence. He had coached Dynamo soccer and had coached several sports for the Momence Youth Sports Organization. He enjoyed tennis and golf. Surviving are his wife, the former Laura N. Nutting, whom he married Aug. 2, 1980, in Momence; one son, Nicholas Moline of Momence; two daughters, Megan Moline of Kankakee and Ashley Moline of Momence; his father of Loda; his mother, Janet Cromer of Oxford, Ohio; two sisters and one brother-in-law, Laura and Ken Heidrich of Manhattan and Olivia Moline of Champaign; and maternal grandmother, Jeanette Jones of Holiday, Fla. Two brothers, Gregory and Scott Moline, are deceased.

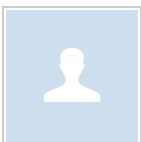
