Mark N. Morris, age 41 of St. Anne passed away Thursday, November 27, 2014 in Iroquois County from injuries sustained in a motor vehicle accident. 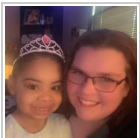

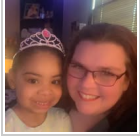
