Mark Robert Simmons, age 63, of Saint Anne passed away Thursday, December 27th, 2018 in his home after a year long battle with pancreatic cancer, surrounded by his loving family.

Mark was born on March 9th, 1955 in Kankakee. Son of Mary Lou and Robert Simmons of Saint Anne. He married Julie Purcell on November 26, 1977 in Watseka. They had two children, Karli (Simmons) Goodrich and Alexander Robert Simmons.

Mark recently retired from the United States Postal Service after serving over 20 years. Prior to that, he was part owner of Simmons & Simmons Construction, working side by side with his father.

One of Mark's greatest loves in life was music. He picked up a guitar when he was 12 years old and never put it down. From there, Mark played in several different self-made bands including Taxi, Route 1, and After Midnight Blues. He and his band members spent countless hours creating, producing, and recording four albums. Music was Mark's passion. He also enjoyed working outside in his yard, camping, and he loved the Chicago White Sox.

Surviving are his daughter Karli (Simmons) Goodrich and son-in-law Andy Goodrich of Saint Anne; two grandchildren, Taylor Simmons of Saint Anne and Liam Goodrich of Saint Anne; his parents, Mary Lou and Robert Simmons of Saint Anne; his sister, Linda (Simmons) Libby and brother-in-law David Libby of Kankakee; his brother, Gary Simmons and sister-in-law Donna Simmons of Saint Anne; his sister-in-law, Melody (Purcell) Higgins of

Bourbonnais; and 15 nieces and nephews.

Mark was preceded in death by his beloved wife and son, Julie and Alex. He was also preceded in death by his grandparents Alex and Louise Boudreau, and Robert and Alice Simmons.

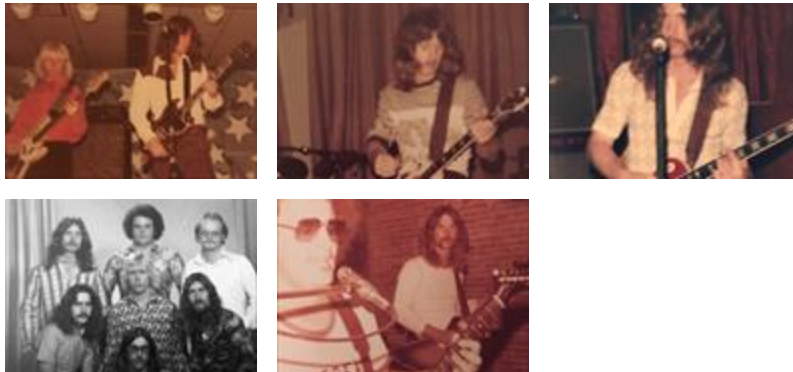

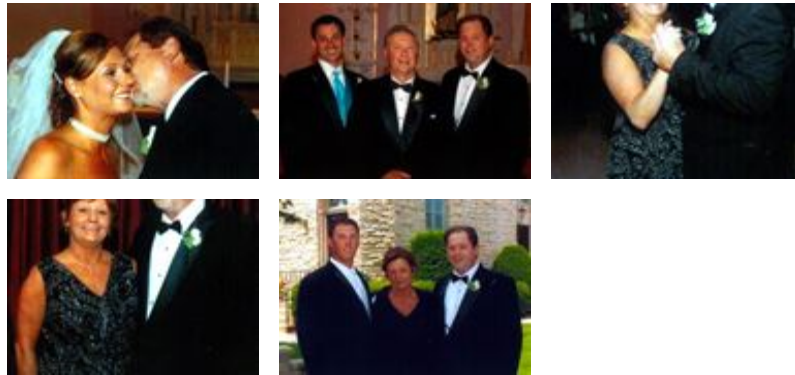
