Marlene D. LaMotte, age 74, of Momence passed away Friday, May 18, 2018 at Rush University Medical Center in Chicago. She was born December 8, 1943 in Kankakee, the daughter of Irvie & Alice Seitz Grimes. Marlene married Jim LaMotte on August 4, 1962 at St. Patrick Church in Momence.

Marlene and her husband, Jim, have been devoted volunteers at Good Shepherd Manor since they opened their doors in 1971. For many years, Marlene was head of volunteers and together they served as committee members of the annual Fall Festival. In 2002, the LaMottes were presented with the organization's "Amicus Certus Award" (Latin for "True Friend") in recognition of their long-time dedication to the Manor.

Marlene was a dedicated wife and mother. She lovingly supported her husband throughout his career at Custom Farm Seed and during his tenure with the Momence Fire Protection District. She was highly involved at St. Patrick Academy and Bishop McNamara High School during the years her daughters attended. She and Jim served as chairpersons of Madcaps in 1983.

Marlene was a volunteer for Hospice of Kankakee Valley. She was a parishioner of St. Patrick Church in Momence and also a member of its Council of Catholic Women.

She was an avid reader. She loved traveling with her husband, golfing, and attending live theatre, plays, and musicals. Marlene's greatest joy was being with her family. She enjoyed cooking family meals and attending her grandchildren's various activities.

Surviving are her husband, Jim LaMotte of Momence; three daughters and three sons-in-law, Lori and Don Henry, Sandy and Bob Malpasuto, and Jackie and Bill Haas, all of Bourbonnais; and seven grandchildren, Jill Henry, Ashley (Erik) Michener, Aryn Henry, Jack Malpasuto, Mike Malpasuto, Nicole Haas, and Ben Haas. Marlene is preceded in death by her parents and one sister, Marilyn Martin.

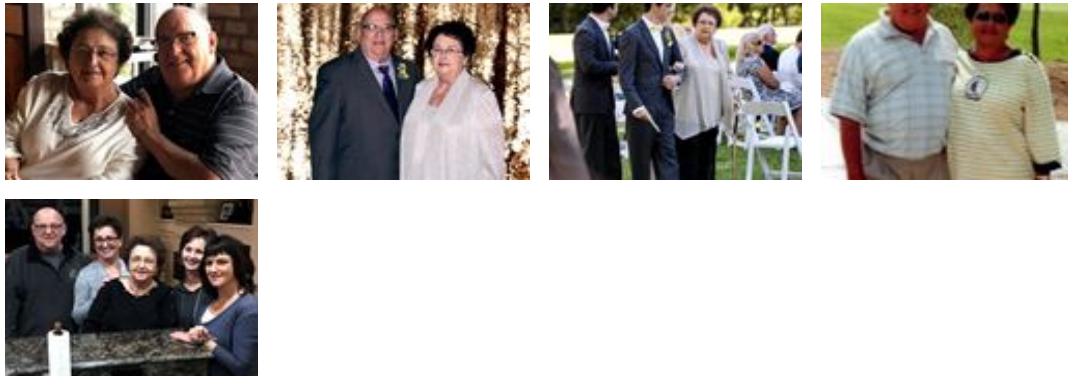
