Martin Dale Duby, age 93, of St. Anne, passed away Tuesday, February 9, 2016 at the Illinois Veterans Home in Manteno. He was born July 1, 1922 in St. Anne, the son of Walter & Ivy Martin Duby.

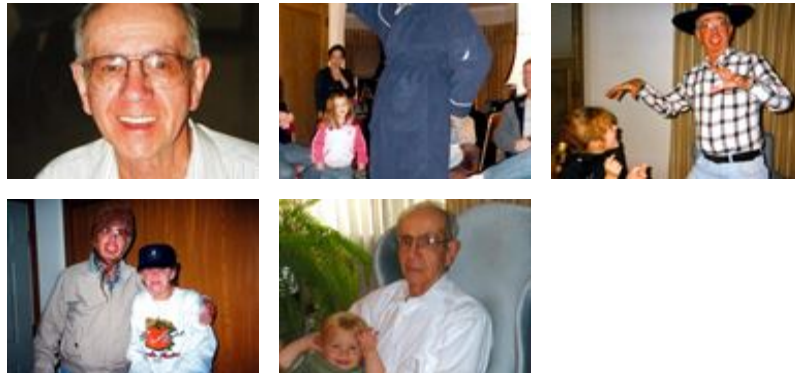
