Visitation for Martin A. Hansen, 92, of Bourbonnais, will be held from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Thursday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home in Bourbonnais, and from 9 a.m. Friday at Bradley First Church of the Nazarene, until the 10 a.m. funeral service. The Rev. Robert Hollowell will officiate. Burial will be in Kankakee Memorial Gardens, Aroma Township. Memorials may be made to the family wishes. He died Sunday (Oct. 17, 2010) at ManorCare Health Services. Mr. Hansen retired from Swift Oil (now Bunge Oil) in Bradley after 25 years of service. He also worked for 10 years at Roper Corp. in Kankakee, was a factory worker at Armour Pharmaceutical and worked briefly at Gould Battery and the Joliet Arsenal. He was born Aug. 27, 1918, in Gilman, the son of Martin and Carrie Hilderbrandt Hansen. His wife, the former Neva M. Ross, whom he married March 12, 1952, in Gilman, died Dec. 30, 2003. He served five years in the U.S. Marines during World War II in the Pacific. Surviving are one son, Paul Hansen, of Bourbonnais; and many nieces and nephews and their families. Deceased are his parents and 13 siblings.
