Visitation for Mary V. Blanchette, 75, of Manteno, will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Friday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home in Bourbonnais. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Saturday at St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church in Kankakee. Father Charles Wheeler and Father Vern Arseneau will officiate. Mrs. Blanchette retired from St. Mary's Hospital after 35 years, where she was an emergency room registered nurse, and had also worked in the Kankakee County Corrections Department. She was born May 3, 1935, in Joliet, the daughter of Sylvester and Mary Staley Spreitzer. Her husband, Vernon O. Blanchette, whom she married in 1956 at St. Raymond Catholic Church in Joliet, died Jan. 19, 2001. She received her Bachelor of Science degree in nursing from St. Mary's School of Nursing and also graduated from St. Francis in Joliet. She was a member of the Red Hat Society and was an avid Chicago White Sox fan. She enjoyed playing bingo and cards, and attending her grandchildren's sporting events. Surviving are two sons and daughters-in-law, Randy and Mary Blanchette, and Rick and Mia Blanchette, all of Manteno; one daughter and son-in-law, Melanie and Ron Grubbs, of Bradley; nine grandchildren, Eric Blanchette, Danielle (Matt) Warchol, Scott Blanchette, Marc Blanchette, Lauren Grubbs, Morgan Grubbs, Connor, Joseph, and Samantha Blanchette; three sisters and two brothers-in-law, Marlene and Jack
