



## Mary D. Gordon

August 21, 1927 - October 27, 2014

Mary Doris Gordon, age 87, of Bradley, IL, peacefully passed on October 27, 2014.

Mary was born on August 21, 1927, in Fargo, ND, to Frederick and Zula Fischer, the sixth of fourteen children. The family farmed and raised turkeys. When Mary's father died suddenly in 1945, she supported her mother with the farm and younger siblings.

Mary graduated from Sacred Heart Academy in Fargo. On September 2, 1948, Mary married Roy Gordon at St. Mary's Cathedral in Fargo. Roy died on February 22, 1994, after 45 years of marriage. Together they raised seven children. She worked at General Foods and retired from Kankakee Terrace after 33 years of service.
