She was retired from Manteno Mental Health Center and had also worked at Shapiro Developmental Center, where she had taught in the nursing education departments. She had also worked at St. Mary's Hospital and did private duty nursing. She was born Oct. 20, 1917, in Chebanse, the daughter of Frank and Bridget Holland Butler. Her husband, Joe Gulczynski, whom she married June 1, 1946, at St. Patrick's Catholic Church, Kankakee, died Feb. 23, 2006. She was a graduate of St. Mary's School of Nursing and received a bachelor's degree from St. Francis College in Joliet. She was a member of the Daughters of Isabella and the Bradley American Legion Auxiliary. She helped organize and was former board president of Harbor House. She was also a volunteer for St. Mary's Hospital and the American Red Cross. She enjoyed silk flower arranging. Surviving are two sons and daughters-in-law, Pat and Lynese Gulczynski of Barron, Wis., Mike and Pam Gulczynski of Kankakee; three daughters and two sons-in-law, MaryAnn and Dennis Condit of Kankakee, Julie Glenn of Chebanse, GERALYN and Ron Orta of Snohomish, Wash.; nine

grandchildren and five great-grandchildren; and one brother, Walter J. Butler of Tempe, Ariz. Deceased are one son, James; four sisters, Irene Moss, Frances Hagan, Alice Hoagard, infant Julia; and two brothers, Bud Butler and Stanley Butler.
