Mary Jane Olley, 92, passed away peacefully on February 28, 2020, leaving behind a legacy of love and laughter. In her younger years, she enjoyed bowling. Particularly skillful at Scrabble, she would often win the game with just one well-placed letter. She also enjoyed birdwatching and embroidery. She was an artist in the kitchen, and her pizzelle cookies and sour cream knot cookies were favorites at many family gatherings. Mary Jane was a faithful and devoted member of the Church, most recently of St. Joseph's Church in Manteno, IL., and was previously involved in the Altar and Rosary Society at St. Donatus.

Mary Jane is preceded in death by her parents, five brothers and three sisters, a daughter born into heaven, and her daughter, Lorraine Olley Eustice.
