



## Mary Salkeld

September 12, 1939 - January 16, 2009

Visitation for Mary K. Salkeld, 69, of Kankakee, will be from 2 p.m. to 6 p.m. today at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 11 a.m. Monday at St. Patrick Catholic Church, Kankakee. The Rev. John Peeters will officiate. Inurnment will be in All Saints Cemetery Mausoleum. Memorials may be made to St. Patrick Catholic Church, where she was a member and Eucharistic minister; or to Hospice of Kankakee Valley. Mrs. Salkeld died Friday (Jan. 16, 2009) at her home. Mrs. Salkeld retired from Lang Distributing after 36 years. She was born Sept. 12, 1939, in Kankakee, the daughter of James W. and Hester Lockwood Quigley. Her husband, Duane T. Salkeld, whom she married Dec. 1, 1979, died Oct. 22, 2001. She was a graduate of St. Patrick Grade School and High School. She was a dedicated volunteer in the gift shop at Provena St. Mary's Hospital and Provena Seconds to Go. She had also volunteered at Heritage Village. She was an avid Chicago Cubs fan and bridge player. She loved to travel, especially to visit her children and grandchildren, and was a gracious caretaker for her family. Surviving are three sons and one daughter-in-law, Timothy Salkeld of Virginia Beach, Va., Matthew and Kerry Salkeld of Holly Springs, N.C., Luke Salkeld of Sumpter, S.C.; one daughter, Becky Work of Poulsbo, Wash.; nine grandchildren, Ryan, Ashley, Matthew Jr. and Erika Salkeld, Timothy and Megan Work, Sean Benton, Brad and Hannah Salkeld; one sister and brother-in-law, Margaret and Dave Ayers of Kankakee, and their son, Danny; one brother-in-law and sister-in-law, Bill and Faye Salkeld of
