



Mary Anne Steele

December 22, 1938 - April 19, 2009

On Sunday (April 19, 2009) Mary Anne Cheffer Steele met her Lord and Savior face to face. Those she has left behind will remember her devotion to her Lord, family, and students. She started her teaching career in 1960 after graduating from Wheaton College and continued to serve the students of this area until she became ill, having influenced thousands of lives over those years. She was recognized for 25 years of teaching at Kankakee Community College. She was a lifelong resident of rural St. Anne, the daughter of Albert and Iza Soucie Cheffer. Her parents are deceased. She married her husband, Wilbur F. Steele, in July 1961. He preceded her in death in 1993. She leaves behind two sons and daughters-in-law, Thomas and Janice Steele of St. Anne and Michael and Lisa Steele of Bradley. She also leaves six dearly loved grandchildren, Stephanie, Kimberly, Kristina, Jennifer, Benjamin and Joshua Steele as well as many cousins, sisters-in-law and brothers-in-law; and nieces and nephews. Visitation will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Wednesday at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee, and from 9 a.m. Thursday at Immanuel Baptist Church, Kankakee, until the 10 a.m. services. Burial will be in Mount Airy Cemetery, Momence. Memorials may be made to her grandchildren's education or to the Bible Witness Camp.
