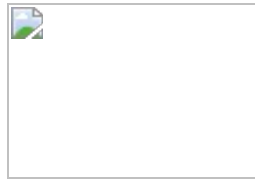

“ I am writing to you to give my sincere sympathies. You do not know me, but I heard about the incident with Matthew on the radio and was instantly upset to hear this news. My fiance, Derrick Gaddis, died on June 6, 2010 in Gilman, IL after he played softball. He played a double header, played his normal game that day. After the game, he was high-fiving his teammates, grabbed a beer from the cooler, then collapsed. The softball team started CPR immediately until the ambulance arrived. He was rushed to the hospital where he was pronounced dead. He was 42 years of age. The autopsy revealed mitral valve prolapse which is a birth defect of the heart that he never knew he had. If he did know, he could have treated it. Derrick never complained of any heart problems.

When I heard about Matthew on the radio, well, I can't really even express how I felt. I thought I would right to you in hopes that you could contact me to talk. My phone number is listed above, so please feel free to contact me.

Again, you are in my thoughts and prayers. I truly understand how you feel at this time as I am still grieving.
