Maureen Ann Rapier-Kufa, 59, of Manteno, passed away Tuesday (June 2, 2015) listening to soft waves of the ocean, surrounded by her loving wife, children, pastor and hospice caregivers, at her home after a long battle with cancer.

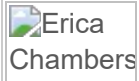
