Mayda J. Voss, 77, of St. Anne, passed away peacefully on June 27, 2015, at her home, with her loving family by her side, after a courageous battle with cancer.

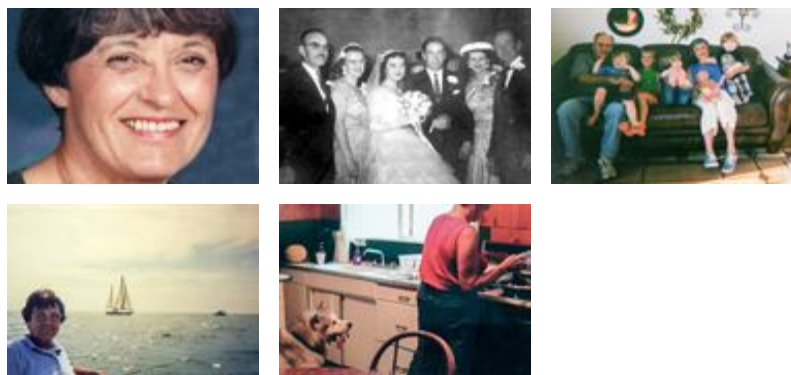
