Maynard J. Cyrier, 84, of Kankakee, died Friday (Nov. 19, 2010) in Kankakee. Visitation will be from 3 p.m. to 7 p.m. Monday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home in Bourbonnais. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 11 a.m. Tuesday at St. Teresa Catholic Church in Kankakee. The Rev. Tom Cargo will officiate. Entombment will be in All Saints Cemetery Mausoleum in Bourbonnais.
