Michael L. Dietchweiler, 61, of Watseka, passed away Sunday (July 26, 2015) at his home. He was born Aug. 14, 1953, in Kankakee, the son of Ralph and Naomi Hornstein Dietchweiler. Michael married Ann Pombert in January 1980 in Kankakee.

Mr. Dietchweiler was an attorney and a partner in LeBeau and Dietchweiler and Associates. He was a graduate of Eastridge High School, Drake University and John Marshall Law School. He was a member of the Kankakee Bar Association and was admitted to practice in front of the Illinois Supreme Court, Central District Court of Illinois and U.S. Court of Appeals Seventh Circuit. He was a marksman and had been a part-time police officer in Watseka and Grant Park. He performed military police action with the Israel Armed Forces as an EOD Tech.

He also was a pilot, beekeeper, wine connoisseur and enjoyed beer making and gardening.

Surviving are his wife, of Watseka; son, Noah Pombert, of Watseka; mother, of Jupiter, Fla.; and brothers, Alan Dietchweiler and Daniel Dietchweiler.

His father preceded him in death.
