Michael E. Kellogg, 69, of Kankakee passed away March 5, 2020 at Edward Hines, Jr. VA Hospital in Proviso Township, IL.

He was born January 7, 1951 in Kankakee, the son of Elmer and Doreen (Houde) Kellogg. They preceded him in death, in addition to his sister, Anita Grant; 2 brothers, Patrick and Martin Arseneau; and his daughter, Courtney Wojcik.

Surviving are his wife, Deborah (Brouillette), of Kankakee; his brother, Eugene Kellogg, of Carrollton, TX; his son, Mikah (Katherine) Kellogg, of Park Ridge, IL; and 2 grandchildren, Evelyn and Preston Kellogg, of Park Ridge, IL. Mike, or "Log," as he was affectionately known, enlisted into the US Army upon graduating from Eastridge High School in 1969 and served 4 years on active duty, including a tour in Viet Nam with the 1st Cavalry Infantry Division in 1971. He was honorably discharged as a sergeant in 1972 and married Deborah Brouillette on June 2, 1973 in Kankakee.

Mike was a foreman with several union underground construction companies for over 30 years and retired in 2013. He was a member of the Aroma Park

American Legion. Mike enjoyed home renovation, playing golf and spending time with friends and family.

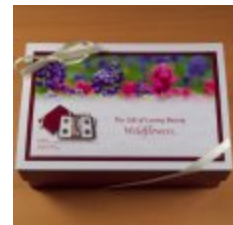
