After graduating from Gallagher Business School she worked as a secretary for Sanford Lasser at Lasser's Furniture until it burned and then continued as a secretary for the doctors at Shapiro Developmental Center. She was born Oct. 14, 1913, in Kankakee, the daughter of John U. and Kathryn Sauer Kukuck. Her husband, William J. Roy, whom she married Nov. 25, 1946, in Kankakee, died Feb. 21, 1973. She was a lifelong member of St. Mark United Methodist Church, where she sang in the choir, taught Sunday school and substituted as a pianist. She loved music and playing the piano.

Surviving are one sister, Elinor M. Kukuck, of Kankakee; and many cousins.

She was preceded in death by her parents.

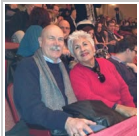
