Mollie McIntyre -- Bradley Visitation for Mollie Metschuleit McIntyre, 95, a lifelong Bradley resident, will be from 2 p.m. to 5 p.m. Sunday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Monday at St. Joseph Catholic Church, Bradley, where she was a lifelong member. The Rev. John Antczak will officiate. Burial will be in Mt. Calvary Cemetery, Kankakee. Memorials may be made to St. Joseph Catholic Church or to St. Joseph Grade School. She died Wednesday (March 12, 2008) at the Miller Center in Kankakee. Mrs. McIntyre was employed at the Bear Brand Hosiery Co. and Kroehler Manufacturing Co. for many years. She was born Aug. 22, 1912, in Bradley, the daughter of Leo and Margaret Gerdersich Pechauer. Her first husband, Erich Metschuleit, whom she married Feb. 22, 1930, died Feb. 28, 1975. She later married Kenneth McIntyre. He is also deceased. She served as past president of the Women's CCW and was the current president of the Local Slovenian Women's Union. She enjoyed traveling, crocheting, playing cards and serving on church committees. Surviving are two sons and daughters-in-law, Joseph and Lucille Metschuleit of Bourbonnais, Donald and Ruth Metschuleit of Paducah, Ky.; 10 grandchildren and 17 great-grandchildren; and several nieces and nephews. Deceased are three brothers, Johnny, Rudy and Leo Pechauer; and three sisters, Margaret Hassett, Anna LaMontagne and Mary Ward.

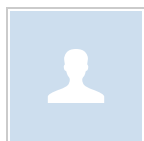
