



## M. Roberta Wright

February 11, 1916 - July 14, 2005

Martha Roberta Glavind Wright, 89, of Bourbonnais, died Thursday (July 14, 2005) at Provena Our Lady of Victory Nursing Home. She and her late husband came to this area from Los Angeles, Calif., in October of 1997. Mrs. Wright was born in Weeping Water, Neb., Feb. 11, 1916, the second daughter of Lawrence and Retta Knight Glavind. She graduated from high school in Wessington Springs, S.D., in 1934, and from Seattle Pacific College, now Seattle Pacific University, Seattle, Wash., in 1938. Mrs. Wright was a very busy wife and mother. She was active in her church, the Glendale Free Methodist Church in Glendale, Calif. She enjoyed reading, sewing and growing several varieties of African violets. She and her husband traveled much throughout the lower United States and Alaska.
