



## Myrl P. Billadeau

August 12, 1917 - March 14, 2018

Myrl P. Billadeau, age 100, of Bourbonnais passed away Wednesday, March 14, 2018 at Riverside Medical Center. He was born August 12, 1917 in Kankakee, the son of Meddie & Bessie Dahling Billadeau. He married Mildred M. Kunde on February 7, 1942 at St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church Rectory in Kankakee. She preceded him in death on June 6, 2008.

Myrl retired from Roper Corporation, formerly known as Florence Stove, in Kankakee after 46 years. He was an avid fisherman, golfer and bowler. He enjoyed swimming. In his later years, he enjoyed watching the Chicago Cubs and Chicago White Sox on television. Myrl was a lifelong parishioner at St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church in Kankakee and a very active volunteer.
