



Dr. Nemesio S. Miguel Sr.

December 19, 1922 - May 25, 2015

Dr. Nemesio "Neming" Serquina Miguel, 95, of Bourbonnais, passed away Monday (May 25, 2015) in Kankakee.

He was born Dec. 19, 1919, in the Philippines, the son of Candido Salamanca and Victoriana Serquina Miguel. He married Soledad M. Lim-Miguel on Sept. 14, 1953.

Dr. Miguel was a physician at Woodward Hospital in Woodward, Iowa. He graduated from the University of Santo Tomas in the Philippines in 1949, and trained at Jersey Shore University Medical Center in New Jersey with a specialty in pathology.

He enjoyed the outdoors, cars and was a well-versed mechanic. He was the first to build a radio for his hometown in 1938, in San Nicolas, Pangasinan.
