Nijole R. Genys Poskus was born September 2, 1924 in Klaipeda, Lithuania, to Colonel Petras Genys and Wilhemina Genys. She married Balys Poskus in Heidelberg, Germany on September 28, 1946. They emigrated to the United States in 1949 and eventually settled in Kankakee, Illinois, where her husband was a physician. She died on August 20, 2015.
