Mr. Lambert was a retired Beaverville area farmer. He was born Oct. 4, 1926, in Beaverville, the son of Noel and Lilly Arseneau Lambert. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army, serving during World War II. He was a former member of the Lions and the VFW.
