Norman Craig Kibbons, age 71, of Bourbonnais passed away Wednesday, July 22, 2020 at AMITA St. Mary's Hospital in Kankakee. He was born September 5, 1948 in Kankakee, the son of Leonard & Lillian (Landrie) Kibbons. Norman married Shelley Giroux on September 13, 1969 in Kankakee.

Norman was a retired employee of Ameritech, formerly Illinois Bell Telephone, for 31 years. He was a 1966 graduate of Kankakee High School. 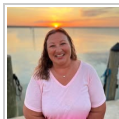
