



## Oswald Bieber

November 25, 1921 - July 15, 2009

Visitation for Oswald Bieber, 87, of St. Anne, will be from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. today at the Clancy-Gernon-Houk Funeral Home in St. Anne. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Saturday at St. Anne Catholic Church. The Rev. James Fanale will officiate. Burial will be in St. Anne Catholic Cemetery. Memorials may be made to Provena St. Mary's Hospital or St. Anne Catholic Church. He died Wednesday (July 15, 2009) at Provena St. Mary's Hospital. Mr. Bieber owned and operated St. Anne Grain, M.F. Bieber and Sons (1953) and sold the business in 1974 when he retired. He was born Nov. 25, 1921, in St. Anne, the son of Mathias and Lenore Goyette Bieber. His wife, the former Eleanor Kerr, whom he married Feb. 12, 1947, in St. Anne, died April 10, 2003. He was a village trustee for 10 years in the 1950s and 1960s. He served in the U.S. Navy during World War II in the South Pacific aboard the USS President Jackson. He was a Radioman 1st Class (1943-1945). He was a member of the St. Anne Catholic Church, where he served on the board. He attended radio school at the University of Wisconsin. He was former president of the St. Anne Chamber of Commerce, a member of the St. Anne American Legion, involved in St. Anne Little League and was a member of the Elks. He did volunteer work at Provena St. Mary's Hospital and he enjoyed golfing and watching all sports. Surviving are one son and daughter-in-law, James Allen and Emily Bieber of Austin, Texas; one daughter and son-in-law, Nicky and Mark Beaupre of St. Anne; five grandchildren, Alyse and Ryan Keys, Kari and Matt Leisure, Christopher and Brandy Beaupre, Gretchen Bieber and Janelle

Bieber; four great-grandchildren, Charlie and Anna Lenore Keys, Brook and Lauren Leisure; one sister and brother-in-law, Mary Ann and Marvin Sparenburg of Bountiful, Utah; and one brother and two sisters-in-law, Fred and Oleana Bieber of Bourbonnais, and Audrey Bieber of Sun City, Ariz. Deceased are one grandson, Capt. Ryan Beaupre; and one brother, George Bieber.
