Otto Pobanz -- St. Anne A memorial service for Otto J. Pobanz, 71, of St. Anne, will be held at 10 a.m. Tuesday at Faith Baptist Church in Bourbonnais, where he was a member. Rev. He died Friday (March 10, 2006) in the emergency room at Provena St. Mary's Hospital, Kankakee, after a sudden illness. Mr. Pobanz was a retired truck driver. He was born Aug. 3, 1934, in St. Anne Township, the son of Otto J. and Josephine Lewis Pobanz. His wife, the former Joyce Hardesty, whom he married Aug. 29, 1964, in Morris, died Nov. 8, 2005. He served in the U.S. Air Force during the Korean War. Mr. Pobanz and his wife had a band called "Rovers," and he loved to fish. Surviving are two sons and one daughter-in-law, Troy Pobanz of Bradley and Toby and Deanna Pobanz of St. Anne; one daughter and son-in-law, Kathy and Ed Wise of West Virginia; four sisters and three brothers-in-law, Jean and Don Hexall of Mokena, Patsy and Gene Clementine of Niles, Janet and Duane Blankly of Livingston, Joan Niven of Dunnellon, Fla.; two brothers and one sister-in-law, Bruce Pobanz of St. Petersburg, Fla., Bob and Linda Pobanz of Marsailles; 10 grandchildren and two great-grandchildren. Deceased are three sons.
