Pamela R. Bright, age 54 of Bourbonnais passed away peacefully on Saturday, October 28, 2023, at her home surrounded by her family. She was born on July 12, 1969, in Joliet, the daughter of Robert and Karen (Spice) Dickson. Pamela married Douglas Bright on September 1, 1990, in Joliet. Pamela worked at River Valley Special Recreation Association for close to 19 years. As the Special Olympics coordinator, and later the Executive Director of the RVSRA, Pamela touched hundreds of lives of people with disabilities and their families. Her biggest joy in life was her two daughters, with whom she loved to shop and bake. She also enjoyed traveling and was a fan of fastpitch softball.

Surviving is her husband, Douglas of Bourbonnais; her mother, Karen Dickson of Joliet; two daughters, Kelsey Bright of Peotone, and Sydney Bright of Momence; and one brother, Jim Dickson of Joliet.

Pamela is preceded in death by her father, Robert Dickson.
