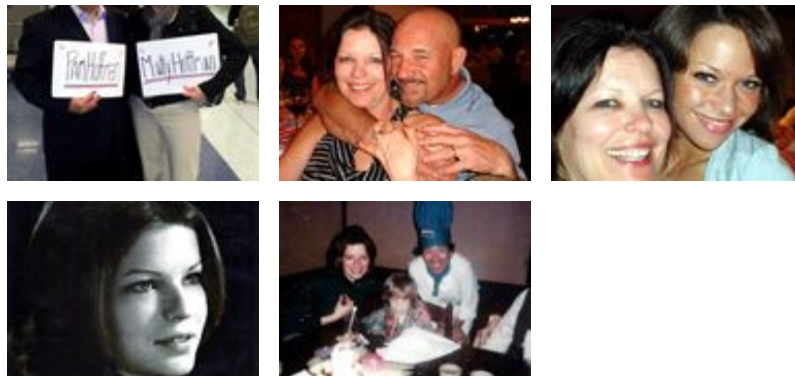

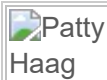

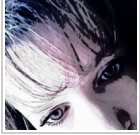
“ Matt and family---
