Patricia Brouillet Brault passed away early in the morning on June 18, 2008 at the age of 77. A memorial service will be held from 10 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. Saturday, Aug. 2, at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home in Bourbonnais. Graveside services will follow. They married in 1953 and resided in the Kankakee area for the next 34 years to raise their family. Patricia is survived by her husband of 54 years, Joel. She is also survived by her daughters and their families: daughter, Michelle Chandler and husband David, granddaughter Meagan Rosser and husband Neil and granddaughter Beth Chandler, all of Pearland, Texas; daughter Kathie Brault of Naperville; daughter Cindy O'Connell and husband Randy, granddaughter Robin O'Connell, all of Peotone. Also surviving is her brother, Randy Brouillet and wife Tanya of Bainbridge, Ga., and many nieces and nephews. Patricia was a stay-at-home mom and after her children started to leave home she became marketing director for Meadowview Shopping Center in Kankakee. Following a move to the western suburbs of Chicago, she became active as a professional volunteer for several years at Good Samaritan Hospital. During this time she

became close to the Chicago Bears organization. She created and coordinated the production of a world-renowned Super Bowl poster for the team. While residing in the Tucson area for the past 10 years, she continued her volunteerism, assisting families with terminally ill children.
