Visitation for Patricia A. Clodi, 63, of St. Anne, will be from 5 p.m. to 8 p.m. Friday, with a 6 p.m. Women of the Moose service, at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 9:30 a.m. Saturday at St. Teresa Catholic Church, Kankakee. The Rev. Thomas Cargo will officiate. Burial will be in Sts. Peter and Paul Cemetery, Herscher. Memorials may be made to the American Diabetes Association, the Women of the Moose or to Provena Heritage Village, Kankakee. She died Sunday (Nov. 2, 2008) at her home. Ms. Clodi was retired from Tinley Park Mental Health Center. She had also worked at Manteno Mental Health Center. She was a graduate of Herscher High School and Kankakee Community College. She was the current president of both the Ladies of the Moose and the Kankakee Chapter of the General Federation of Women's Clubs. She was a volunteer at Provena Heritage Village and Provena St. Mary's Hospital. Surviving are two cousins, Dennis (Diane) Clodi of Oswego, and Raymond (Nancy) Clodi of Mokena. Deceased are her parents, and stepmother, Frances (Hamilton) Clodi.

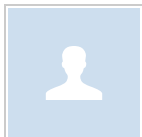

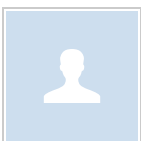
