Patricia Maxine Paul, 69, died Friday May 20, 2016 at her home in Bourbonnais after a sudden illness. Mrs. Paul was born on July 25, 1946 in Fort Riley, Kansas, the daughter of William and Una (Steele) Rodgers. She is survived by her husband, James, whom she married on March 21, 1970; one daughter and son-in-law, Christina and Andrew Bradley of Frankfort, Illinois; granddaughter Cayla and grandson Raylan; one sister and brother-in-law, Barbara and Thomas Gross of Westminster, Colorado; and many nieces, nephews, great nieces, and great nephews.

A memorial visitation will be held at Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home in Bourbonnais from 5 to 7:00 p.m. on Wednesday, May 25, 2016 with music and testimonials at 7:00 p.m. In lieu of flowers, memorials may be made to Harbor House or New Beginnings for Cats.

Before her retirement in 2005, Mrs. Paul taught history, government, and journalism at Herscher High School for 33 years. While at Herscher High School, she served as union building representative for many years, and state curriculum representative to various conferences in Illinois. She was also an adjunct professor at Kankakee Community College teaching the Introduction to the Humanities course. She served as a chaplain, historian, and state representative in the Beta Xi Chapter of Alpha Delta Kappa teaching sorority. After retirement, Mrs. Paul continued to teach as a substitute teacher at Momence High School for several years; served on the board of trustees for the Bourbonnais Public Library; volunteered in the Stable Shop at the Bradley

House; enjoyed quilting with her Sewing Sisters at Vana's; traveled to all seven continents and 49 states; planned the artwork for her garden; played bridge with her friends; participated in social activities; and was Mom/Grammie/Aunt Maxie/Auntie Pat/Maxie to her dear family. She will be greatly missed by her family and friends.

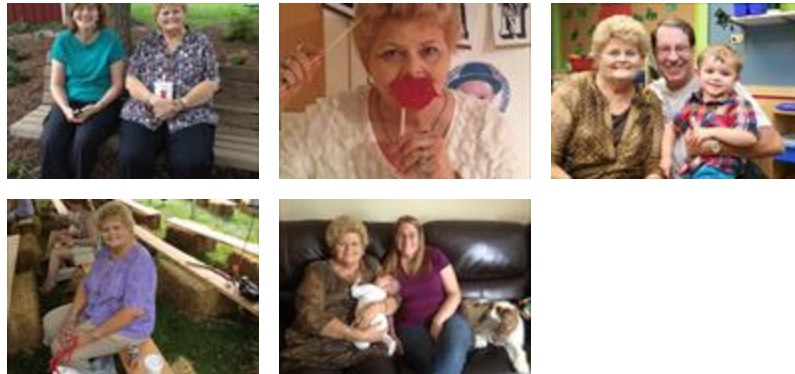
