Patricia Picucci -- Kankakee Visitation for Patricia L. "Patty" Picucci of Kankakee, will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Tuesday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 11 a.m. Wednesday at St. Patrick Catholic Church. Burial will be in Mt. Calvary Cemetery. Memorials may be made to the family wishes. Mrs. Picucci died Friday (July 11, 2008) in the emergency room at Silver Cross Hospital in Joliet, following a sudden illness. Mrs. Picucci was a homemaker. She was also an account manager for Dr. Olofsson and LaBeau, Dietchweiler and Associates. She also sold Avon. She was born in Ossining, N.Y., the daughter of Nicholas and Harriet Johnson LaLuna. She was a mother to her family and a second "ma" to everyone else, who lived each and every day to its fullest potential. She enjoyed bowling, cooking, spending time with friends, working for others, but most of all -- attending, watching, and enjoying every single moment in her children's lives. Her volunteer work at Sts. Patrick and Teresa School included bake sales, concession stands, Santa's Secret Shop, cookie walks, being a room parent for every class party, donating and preparing the flowers for second grade's First Communion, writing the PTC newsletter, and coaching the cheerleading squad. Volunteer work at Bishop McNamara High School included being a member of the School Board, soccer team pasta dinners, and the annual auction. She was a member of St. Ann Church in Ossining, N.Y., where she was married, as well as an active parishioner at St. Patrick Catholic Church in Kankakee. Surviving are her husband, Steven J.

Picucci, whom she married May 9, 1970; two sons, Angelo Picucci of St. Louis, Mo., Stevie Picucci at home; one daughter and son-in-law, Briana and Mike Beckner of Indianapolis, Ind.; two sisters, Gloria Nestor of Peekskill, N.Y., Debbie Jamros of Mokena; two brothers and one sister-in-law, Robert LaLuna, Nicholas and Melissa LaLuna, all of Kankakee; and several nieces and nephews. Deceased are her parents and one infant brother, Bobby.
