Memorial visitation for Patricia A. Wroblewski, 81, of Bourbonnais, will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Thursday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home in Bourbonnais. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 11 a.m. Friday at Maternity BVM Catholic Church in Bourbonnais, where she was a member. Father Richard Pighini will officiate.

Cremation rites have been accorded. Inurnment will be in Immaculate Conception Cemetery in Dieterich. Memorials may be made to the family wishes. She died Saturday (July 9, 2011) at Riverside Medical Center.

Mrs. Wroblewski owned and operated the Convenient Food Mart on Convent Street in Bourbonnais from 1988 to 1994. She was born Oct. 1, 1929, in Blue Island, the daughter of Clemens and Beatrice Wooley Ohlendorf. Her husband, Richard T. Wroblewski, whom she married May 22, 1949, at St. Donatus Church in Blue Island, died Jan. 20, 1985. She did volunteer work at her church and Provena St. Mary's Hospital, where she was also a member of the hospital auxiliary. She also did volunteer work for Riverside Senior Advantage. She enjoyed reading, quilting and doing jigsaw puzzles. She loved her cat.

Surviving are three sons and daughters-in-law, Steven and Susan Wroblewski, and Chris and Kim Wroblewski, all of Bourbonnais, and Ray and

Jackie Wroblewski, of Kankakee; one daughter, Kerry Coffman, of Orland Park; six grandchildren, Marc, Rich (Sarah), Rebecca (John), Kristin, Amber and Dennis; two great-grandchildren, Elizabeth and Abigail; and one brother, John Ohlendorf, of Bourbonnais.

She was preceded in death by her parents.
