Patrick S. Pence, 65, of Bourbonnais passed away on Thursday, September 25, 2014 at Presence St. Mary's Hospital in Kankakee. He was born on July 29, 1949 in Litchfield, Illinois to Harold W. and Audrey J. (Gurick) Pence. Pat married Elizabeth "Liz" A. McDonald on August 28, 1971 in Granite City, Illinois.

He retired from Bourbonnais Upper Grade Center after 38 years of teaching Social Studies. Pat was the President of the Bradley Bourbonnais Teachers Credit Union for more than 20 years, which became Elite Credit Union where he currently served on the board. He was a supporter, walker, and fundraiser for the American Cancer Society and served on the Luminary Committee. He belonged to the Kankakee History Club. Pat was also active at the Country Theatre Workshop in Cissna Park, Illinois; serving on the Board of Directors and participating as a Character Actor. He was an avid gardener, golfer and trivia fan. Pat loved and enjoyed people.

He is survived by his wife, Elizabeth "Liz" A. Pence of Bourbonnais; mother, Audrey Pence of Litchfield, Illinois; two children, Michael Pence and Catherine Ambler of Gales Ferry, Connecticut and Megan Pence and Daniel Stock of Lanesboro, Minnesota; one brother, Michael W. (Patti) Pence of Litchfield, Illinois; and one sister, Cathy A. (Jerry) Pence Vega of Litchfield, Illinois. He was preceded in death by his father.

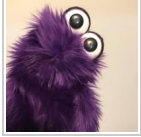
