Paul T. "Slip" Boudreau, age 90, of Bourbonnais, passed away Thursday, September 24, 2020 at AMITA St. Mary's Hospital in Kankakee.

He was born November 27, 1929 in Bourbonnais, the son of Eugene & Anna Lambert Boudreau.

He married Rolaine Tetrault on August 27, 1949 at Maternity B.V.M. Catholic Church in Bourbonnais. She preceded him in death on June 20, 2011.

Slip was a retired mechanical engineer for A.O. Smith Corporation.
