



## Paul Hinderer

September 2, 1921 - May 17, 2013

Visitation for Paul D. Hinderer, 91, of Bourbonnais, will be from 2 p.m. to 6 p.m. Sunday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais, where funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. Monday. Deacon Patrick Skelly will officiate.

Entombment will be in All Saints Cemetery & Mausoleum, Bourbonnais. In lieu of flowers, memorials may be made to the family wishes. He died Friday (May 17, 2013) at ManorCare Health Services in Kankakee.

Mr. Hinderer was retired from Bimba in Monee. He was born Sept. 2, 1921, in Kankakee, the son of Frederick and Alta Rapp Hinderer. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army, serving during World War II. He worked for three years on the Manhattan Project at Los Alamos, N.M., that developed the atomic bomb. He was a 48-year member of St. Mark United Methodist Church. He was also a member of the Moose Lodge, Kankakee American Legion Post 85 and the Vintage Squadron. He was a former member of the Quadrille Club. He was an avid sports fan, especially the Chicago Bears and Chicago Cubs. He enjoyed golfing at Aspen Ridge Golf Course and bowling.

Surviving are his wife, the former Beatrice R. Ruder, of Bourbonnais, whom he married April 30, 1955, at St. Patrick Catholic Church, in Kankakee; two sons and one daughter-in-law, Douglas and Shirley Hinderer, of Arlington Heights,

and Mark Hinderer, of Normal; one daughter and son-in-law, Lisa and Steve Feeney, of Bloomington; 17 grandchildren, Katherine, Amanda, Emily, Thomas, Peter, Monica, Joseph, Samuel, Nicholas, Erin, James, Sara, Andrew, Matthew, Jennifer, Lauren and Kimberly; and two great-grandchildren, Colton and Savannah.
