



Paul Kreft

June 24, 1931 - April 24, 2010

Memorial visitation for Paul W. Kreft, 78, a lifetime resident of Kankakee and Bonfield, prior to retiring to Melbourne, Fla., in 1984, will be from 4 p.m. Thursday until the 7 p.m. memorial service at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee. The Rev. Joel Giles will officiate. Graveside services will be held at 10 a.m. Friday in Bonfield Cemetery. Memorials may be made to Hospice of Kankakee Valley. He died Saturday (April 24, 2010) at his residence. Mr. Kreft retired from Uniroyal (Joliet Army Ammunition Plant) in October 1977 as a production control manager. He was born June 24, 1931, in Kankakee, the son of Walter and Anna Rheubottom Kreft. His wife, the former Betty Lou Rettke, whom he married June 30, 1951, died Aug. 30, 2003. He was a veteran of the U.S. Air Force, serving during the Korean conflict (1950-53). Surviving are four sons and daughters-in-law, Bruce and Paula Kreft of Coral Springs, Fla., Brian and Carol Kreft of Nashua, N.H., Bill and Tammy Kreft of Ashkum, Brad and Pam Kreft of Bonfield; one daughter, Anna Prodehl of Bradley; 12 grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren; and two sisters and one brother-in-law, Audrey Weil of Altorf and Brenda and Barry Starkey of Kankakee. He was preceded in death by his parents and father-in-law and mother-in-law, Carl and Lucille Rettke.

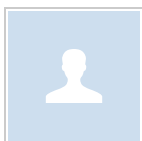

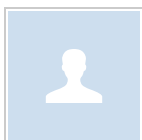
