



Paul Lovell

March 16, 1931 - December 21, 2012

Paul D. Lovell, 81, of Bradley, died Friday (Dec. 21, 2012) at Adventist Hinsdale Hospital. Visitation will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Wednesday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Thursday at St. Joseph Catholic Church, Bradley. Father Tony Nugent will officiate.

Entombment will be in All Saints Cemetery Mausoleum, Bourbonnais. Memorials may be made to St. Joseph Catholic Church or to Bishop McNamara Catholic High School.

Mr. Lovell was a land developer and owner of the Lovell Companies. He was a former employee of General Motors Corp. and a former Bradley policeman. He was born March 16, 1931, in Cabery, the son of Francis and Elizabeth Wagner Lovell. He was a member of the Knights of Columbus, the Elks and the Moose. He was a volunteer at Provena St. Mary's Hospital in Kankakee and was very active at St. Joseph Catholic Church. He was a former president of the Illinois Home Builders Association, former president of the Kankakee County Homebuilders Association, former Bradley Village trustee, former president of the Joliet Diocesan School Board and a former Bourbonnais Township Assessor for more than 30 years.

Surviving are his wife, the former Norma J. Carroll, of Bradley, whom he

married April 21, 1951, at St. Joseph Catholic Church, Cabery; one son and daughter-in-law, Patrick and Anita Lovell, of Bradley; three daughters and sons-in-law, Linda and Michael Jones, of Champaign, Chris and Jim Buckner, of Bradley, and Karen and Paul Raymore, of Logan, Ohio; six grandchildren, Stacey and Ryan Buckner, Christopher Jones, Kevin, Ashley and Matthew Lovell; one sister-in-law, Judy Lovell, of Northbrook; one aunt, Kay Lambert, of Bourbonnais; and several nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his parents; foster parents, Aimee and Margaret Jacob; and one brother, Eugene Lovell.
