Paul M. Taube, 60, of St. Anne, died Sunday (March 7, 2010) at his home. Visitation will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Tuesday at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee, where funeral services will be held at 10 a.m. Wednesday. Interment will be in Abraham Lincoln National Cemetery, Elwood. In lieu of flowers, memorials may be made to the family wishes.
